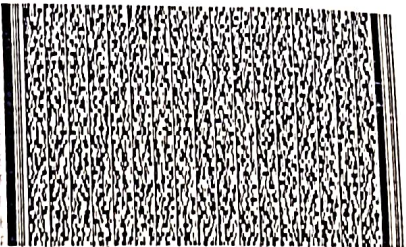

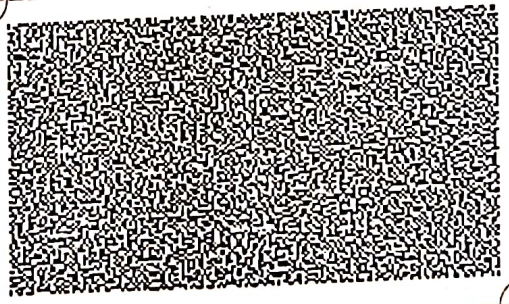

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is executed on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of February 2021 ("Effective Date") and is effective here from the date of execution of the MOU.

BETWEEN


Madhya Pradesh State Open School Education Board (hereinafter referred to as "MPSOSEB") through its Director, Shri Prabhat Raj Tiwari, having office at, Madhyamika Shiksha Mandal Campus, Shivaji Nagar, Bhopal, which is duly established and managed by the Government of Madhya Pradesh and is involved in the business of providing Open School Education services across the state of Madhya Pradesh. This MOU is executed with the willingness and understanding which expression shall unless repugnant to the subject or context mean and include its successors and assignees) of the FIRST PART.

AND

Skill Council for Green Jobs (hereinafter referred to as "SCGJ"), through its Chief Executive Officer, Shri Dr. Praveen Saxena, having office at III Floor, Central Board of Irrigation and Power, (CBIP) Building, Malcha Marg, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi - 110021. The MOU includes its successors and assignees until mentioned otherwise.

This is an MOU between the parties mentioned above regarding institutions working in the field of linking education into the skill development spheres. The objective of this MOU is to ensure the delivery of NSQF (please right it in full) complied training programs, which encompasses complete cycle right from curriculum & content development with assessment of trainers and trainees. The aim is to develop a skill ecosystem for the various crafts that shall focus on preparing Qualification Pack (QP)/ National Occupational Standards (NOS) based training programs and thereby train human resources.





**Roles and Responsibilities of the Madhya Pradesh State Open School Education Board:**

- To Identify and nominate the Centre's job role wise, for the short term and long-term affiliation with the SCGJ.
- To ensure requisite number of labs with tools and equipment, trainers, course material and basic administrative support is made available at the Centre's to deliver competency-based training based on the QPs/NOS.
- To Share the technical and other details of the identified Centre's with SCGJ as per the requirement from time to time.
- To align the curriculum with the relevant SCGJ-Qualification Packs.
- To use high quality, relevant and approved training materials for training
- To nominate trainers for the Training of Trainer workshops initiated by SCGJ from time to time as per mutually agreed date and time.
- To display SCGJ as a preferred partner for assessment and certification at a prominent place in all Centre's participating under this AGREEMENT.
- To ensure mobilization of candidates for various courses and skill development projects.
- To mobilize and register students and maintain accurate and relevant records of students.
- To provide for placement/self-employment assistance to trainees.
- To record and track placement/self-employment for a period of one year post training.
- To provide Industry Validations of the Qualification packs developed by SCGJ in collaboration with MPSOSEB.
- To work in collaboration on conducting Skill Gap Study to identify the needs of the Industry and its stakeholders, both in backward and forward linkage.
- MPSOSEB undertakes to pay the mutually agreed fees to SCGJ for various training

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and assessment activities to be launched by MPBOSEB in collaboration with SCGJ. These activities would include Implementing Skill Development Training Programs based on the needs of the clusters vise Fresh Skilling, Skill upgradation and Recognition of Prior Learning time to time as per the Common Cost Norms and procedural guidelines laid down by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE).

- MPBOSEB would support to develop a center of excellence for green jobs in Bhopal.

#### Roles and Responsibilities for Skill Council for Green Jobs:

- SCGJ and Madhya Pradesh School Education Board agree to work in collaboration on the identification and development of potential crafts (Qualification Packs).
- To bring Industry connect by working with the local industry associations with a view to get industry's inputs for development or revision of Occupational Standards on a periodic basis in order to strengthen the curriculum.
- To organize timely assessment of training through designated Assessment Agencies and Approved Assessors.
- To ensure timely certification as per norms of the particular scheme or as mutually agreed in absence of specific guidelines.
- To share the outcomes of labour
- r market survey or similar studies from time to time.
- To assist in developing processes to strengthen the evidence based internal assessment system of the training centers.
- To ensure skill up-gradation program for the existing Artisans in the various crafts on Entrepreneurship and Employability skills as per the current industry need, product specifications, change in the dynamics, and functionalities of consumers.
- To ensure skill development of youth in the prominent clusters across the potential communities of Madhya Pradesh as per the procedural guidelines laid down by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE).

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- MPSOSEB and SCGJ shall make a collaborative approach in Building-up workforce of new budding entrepreneurs/ artisans and provide awareness about the new design and adaptation methods with the services of experienced designers.
- MPSOSEB and SCGJ shall work in empowering the Artisans and the local communities by conducting collateral community development camps and boot camps in different regions of the clusters where execution of training and up skilling practices can be executed.
- SCGJ will include MPSOSEB as a Training Partner on this project, where required.
- Similarly, SCGJ would arrange to pay the respective charges and fee to MPSOSEB towards providing necessary facilities for the training and assessment activities to be carried out by SCGJ.

## 2. Instruction and approval:

The projects shall be implemented mutually and jointly by the SCGJ and MPSOSEB (implementing agency for skill development training programs) in accordance with the mutually agreed project implementation plan, scope of work, Time frame and payment schedule as set out for both the parties.


## 3. Financial support for the programs:

Both the parties would make appropriate efforts to arrange financial support through their respective connects and affiliations for conducting various training and assessment activities.

A few proposed and prospective financial support models are as follows:

1. Fee based programs to be commenced by MPSOSEB;
2. Fee based programs to be commenced by SCGJ;
3. Fee based programs to be commenced by MPSOSEB and SCGJ jointly.
4. Programs to be organized with the support of Govt. of India/ Madhya Pradesh;
5. Programs to be organized through other funding support options.





Both the parties would pay the respective fees/charges to each other which would be decided mutually on case to case basis in line with the applicable case as mentioned above.

#### 4. Certification of the trainings

Under the said collaboration, MPSEB and SCGJ will issue the certificates to the trainees jointly wherein both of the authorities MPSEB and SCGJ would sign the certificates.

#### 5. Use of logo and branding

Logos and branding of both of the organizations, i.e. MPSEB and SCGJ would be placed appropriately on the promotional material, certificate, media release, reference material etc. Use of the logos and branding would be applicable for the programs and activities to be organized under collaborations.

#### 6. General provisions

1. Nothing contained in MOU shall be construed or have effect as constituting relationship of employer and employee or principal and agent between MPSEB and SCGJ.
2. If there is no clause mentioned for the issues that may arise in due course of time would be resolved mutually and amicably.

#### 7. Amendment

In case during the operation of the agreement, circumstances may arise which call for alteration or modification or amendments are required in any part of the MOU, the parties on mutual agreement in writing shall incorporate such amendments by way of amendments to this Agreement which shall be binding and be followed by the parties. The amendment deed prepared after discussions shall be annexed with the instant MOU and it shall form a part of this MOU.



## 8. Terms of payment and other obligation

1. Both the parties would release funds to the respective parties as per mutually agreed terms to be set out on case-to-case basis so that the respective party can meet approved or agreed expenses of the project and commitments related to the projects as per financial arrangements and scope of work;
2. Financial arrangements and scope of work would be finalized mutually as per the nature of the project as mentioned in Point no. 3 (Financial support for the programs)
3. Both the parties would share the bank account details with each other to release the funds to be paid to the respective parties.

## 9. Utilization certificate


Both the parties shall submit utilization certificate in the mutually agreed Format.

## 10. Jurisdiction

Disputes if any arise in between the parties with respect to the instant MOU, the same shall be resolved amicably and in case the issues are of a nature which cannot be resolved, the same would be referred to an arbitrator and the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall be applicable in such case. All disputes arising between the parties shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts at Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh).

The parties hereto have agreed in the terms and conditions mentioned hereinabove with free will and without any pressure.




