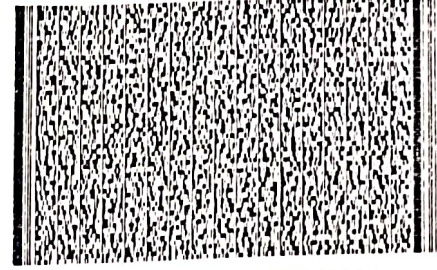

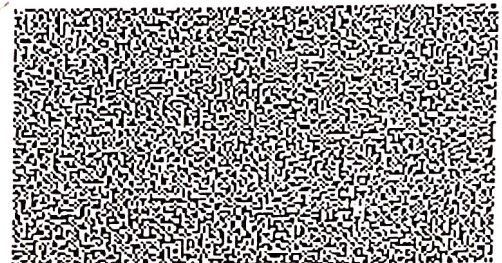

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is executed on this 08 day of July 2021 (“**Effective Date**”) and is effective here from the date of execution of the MOU.

BETWEEN

Whereas **Madhya Pradesh State Open School Education Board (herein referred as MPBOSEB)**, Madhyamika Shiksha Mandal Campus, Shivaji Nagar, Bhopal is duly established and managed by the Government of Madhya Pradesh State and involved in the business of providing Open School Education services across the state of Madhya Pradesh. This MOU is executed with the willingness and understanding which expression shall unless repugnant to the subject or context mean and include its successors and assigns) of the ONE PART.

AND

Textile Sector Skill Council (TSC) a not-for-profit organization registered under Section 8 of Companies Act 2013, having its office at the 14th Floor, Hansalya Building, 15, Barakhamba Road New Delhi-110001 (herein after referred to “TSC”), represented by its CEO, which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the SECOND PART

MPBOSEB and **TSC** hereinafter jointly referred to as “**Parties**” or individually as “**Party**”.

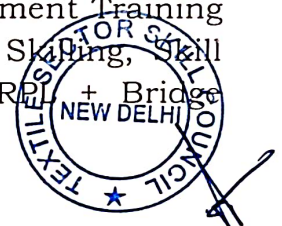
This is an overarching MOU between **MPBOSEB** and **TSC** regarding institutions working in the field of linking education into the skill development spheres. The objective of this MOU is to ensure the delivery of **NSQF** aligned training programs, which encompasses complete cycle, right from curriculum & content development to assessment of trainers and trainees. The aim is to develop a skill ecosystem for the various crafts that shall focus on preparing Qualification Pack (QP)/ National Occupational Standards (NOS) based training programs and thereby train human resources.



Roles and Responsibilities for the Madhya Pradesh State Open School Education Board:

- Identify and nominate the Training centers job roles wise, for the short term and long-term affiliation with the TSC.
- Ensure relevant labs with tools and equipment, trainers, course material and basic administrative support is made available at the Centers to deliver competency-based training based on the QPs/NOS.
- Share the technical and other details of the identified centers with TSC as per the requirement from time to time.
- Align the curriculum with the relevant TSC-Qualification Packs.
- Use high quality, relevant and approved training materials for training.
- Nominate trainers for the Training of Trainer programs conducted by TSC from time to time as per mutually agreed date and time.
- Display TSC as the responsible organization for assessment and certification at a prominent place in all centers participating under this AGREEMENT.
- Mobilize candidates for various courses and skill development projects.
- Register students and maintain accurate and relevant records of students.
- Provide for placement/self-employment assistance to trainees.
- Record and Track placement/self-employment for a period of 1 year post training.
- Provide Industry Validations of the Qualification Packs developed by TSC.
- Work in collaboration with TSC on conducting Skill Gap Study, to identify the needs of the Industry and its stakeholders, both in backward and forward linkage.
- MPBOSEB shall pay the mutually agreed respective fees to TSC for training, assessment, certification activities and development of new QPs or revision of QPs, as applicable, for various programs to be launched by MPBOSEB in collaboration with TSC.
- These activities would include Implementing Skill Development Training Programs based on the needs of the clusters viz Fresh Skilling, Skill Upgradation, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and RPL + Bridge

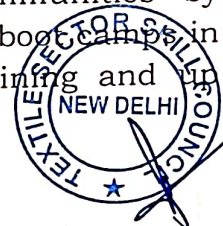
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course as per requirement and mutually agreed upon from time to time as per the Common Cost Norms and procedural guidelines laid down by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE).

Roles and Responsibilities for Textile Sector Skill Council (TSC):

- TSC and Madhya Pradesh State Open School Education Board agree to work in collaboration on the identification and development of potential crafts (Qualification Packs) in Textile Mill and Handloom Sector.
- Bring Industry connect by working with the local industry associations with a view to get industry's inputs for development or revision of Occupational Standards on a periodic basis in order to strengthen the curriculum.
- Organize timely assessment of training through designated Assessment Agencies and Approved Assessors.
- Ensure timely certification as per norms of the particular scheme or as mutually agreed in absence of specific guidelines.
- Share the outcomes of labour market survey or similar studies, if any, from time to time.
- Assist in developing processes to strengthen the evidence based internal assessment system of the training centers.
- Design skill Up-gradation program for the existing Artisans in the various crafts on Entrepreneurship and Employability skills as per the current industry need, product specifications, change in the dynamics, and functionalities of consumers.
- Facilitate skilling of youth in the prominent clusters across the potential communities of Madhya Pradesh as per the procedural guidelines laid down by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE).
- Madhya Pradesh State Open School Education Board and TSC shall make a collaborative approach in building-up workforce of new/budding entrepreneurs/ artisans and provide awareness about the new design and adaptation methods with the services of experienced designers.
- Madhya Pradesh State Open School Education Board and TSC shall work in empowering the Artisans and the local communities by conducting collateral community development camps and boot camps in different regions of the clusters where execution of training



skilling practices can be executed. The funds for the community development camps and boot camps will be arranged by MPSOEB.

2. Instruction and approval:

The project shall be implemented mutually and jointly by the TSC and MPSOEB (implementing agency for skill development training programs) in accordance with the mutually agreed project implementation plan, scope of work, time frame and payment schedules as set out for both parties.

3. Financial support for the programs:

Both of the parties would make appropriate efforts to arrange financial support through their respective connects and affiliations for conducting various training and assessment activities. A few proposed and prospective financial support models are as follows:

1. Fee based programs to be commenced by MPSOEB ;
2. Programs under PMKVY to be facilitated by TSC ;
3. Fee based programs to be commenced by MPSOEB and TSC jointly.
4. Programs to be organized with the support of Govt. of India/ Madhya Pradesh;
5. Programs to be organized through other funding support options.

MPSOEB would pay the respective fees/charges to TSC which would be decided mutually on case to case and prorata basis in line with the applicable case as mentioned above.

4. Certification of the trainings:

Under the said collaboration, MPSOEB and TSC will issue the certificates to the trainees jointly for programs funded by MPSOEB, wherein both of the authorities MPSOEB and TSC would sign the certificates.

5. Use of logo and branding:

Logos and branding of both of the organization MPSOEB and TSC would be placed appropriately on the promotional material, certificate, media release, and reference material etc. for training programs funded by MPSOEB. For training programs funded by any other body, the respective scheme's branding guidelines will be followed. Allowing of the aforementioned use of the logos and

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branding would be applicable for the programs and activities to be organized under collaborations.

6. General provisions:

1. Nothing contained in MOU shall be construed or have effect as constituting relationship of employer and employee or principal and agent between **MPSOSEB** and **TSC**;
2. If there is no clause mentioned for the issues that may arise in due course of time, it would be resolved mutually and amicably.

7. Amendment:

In case during the operation of the agreement, circumstances may arise which call for alteration or modification or amendments are required in any part of the MOU, the parties on mutual agreement in writing shall incorporate such amendments by way of amendments to this Agreement which shall be binding and be followed by the parties.

8. Terms of payment and other obligation:

1. MPSOSEB would release funds to TSC as per mutually agreed terms to be set out on case-to-case basis so that TSC can meet approved or agreed expenses of the project and commitments related to the projects as per financial arrangements and scope of work.
2. Financial arrangements and scope of work would be finalized mutually as per the nature of the project as mentioned in aforementioned point no. 3 (Financial support for the programs).
3. TSC would share the bank account details with MPSOSEB to release the funds to be paid.

9. Utilization certificate:

TSC shall submit utilization certificate in the mutually agreed Performa.




10. Jurisdiction:

1. All disputes arising between the parties shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts in Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh).
